Our Second Act Dance Performances Scheduled at the Children's Museum

Presenting Denver joins forces with the Children's Museum and Rocky Mountain PBS KIDS to feature local artists performing dance numbers inspired by the Museum's unique exhibits

DENVER, Colo. (November 2, 2023) – Celebrate Denver Arts Week with the spirit of dance with two special performances at the Children's Museum of Denver at Marsico Campus on Saturday, November 4, from 6-7 pm and Sunday, November 5, from 1-2 pm.

Our Second Act, A Walking Festival, will feature Colorado artists from Animus Movement, ArtistiCO, LuneAseas, Rocky Mountain Rhythm and Bboy Factory who will perform dance numbers inspired by the exhibits at the Children's Museum, in the exhibits themselves! Performances will take place in Skyline Gallery, Energy, The Art Studio, Fire Station No. 1 and other Museum spaces, creating a one-of-a-kind dance experience.

On Saturday, November 4, performances will take place from 6-7 pm during Night at the Museums and are free for all guests to watch. Please note: Night at the Museums is a Denver Arts Week Open House for everyone, no matter your age. Adults can visit without children that night.

On Sunday, November 5, performances will take place from 1-2 pm during the Museum's regular business hours and are included with the cost of admission. Adults are not allowed in the Museum without children for these performances.
