Performance Schedule

- ◆ **Saturday, November 8:** From **6:30 - 7:30 pm** during Denver Arts Week’s **Night at the Museums!** The Museum is open for free from **5 - 10 pm**, and adults are allowed to explore with or without kids.
- ◆ **Sunday, November 9:** From **10 - 11 am** during the Museum’s regular business hours. Performances are included with the cost of Museum admission, and adults must be accompanied by children to enjoy the performances.
